This year's theme for the recital is "Break Free"! Each year, the production piece is a big hit at the recital – it is about 8-10 minutes in length and involves many characters, scenes, and changes in music. It is like putting on a separate show in the middle of recital. In the past, our production pieces have been to Toy Story (2020), Moana (2019), Aladdin (2018), Beauty & the Beast (2017), Annie (2016), The Wizard of Oz (2015), Disney Princesses (2014), Mary Poppins (2013), Charlie & the Chocolate Factory (2012), and Alice in Wonderland (2011). This year's production will be The Lion King!

While this opportunity is a lot of fun, it is still a big responsibility. Dancers in production will have many weekend practices as well as during the week in Semester 2 (~March-May) that are mandatory! This schedule of practices, costumes, and scenes will all be announced at the beginning of the spring semester. To be a part of production, there is a \$120 fee. This covers practices, extra props, AND your costume. The first half (\$60) is due the FIRST week of December, and acts as a down payment to hold your spot. You may pay this fee early at any time. If we do not receive your payment during the first week of December, we will assume that you do not want to participate. The remaining \$60 is due the FIRST week in January.

Being a part of production is a lot of fun and a great opportunity. While it is not mandatory to participate, we hope you decide to join us this year!

We will be closed for Thanksgiving starting MONDAY 11/23rd. Classes will resume Monday November 30th. The last day of Dance will be Thursday December 17th! We will open again after the holidays on MONDAY January 4th. Tuition and Final \$60 for production will be due this week Jan 6th-9th. We hope you decide to participate!
